Addiction Counselor Ethics:

- This Training is designed to assist professionals in Safeguarding the Welfare of Patients, maintaining Quality of Service and defining and maintaining professional roles that promote recovery and foster client independence, including a better understanding of: Discrimination, Competence (scope of practice), Legal and Moral Issues, Publication Credit, Patient Welfare, Confidentiality, Remuneration and Professional Image
